Costs:

Application Fee – The non-refundable, application fee for all applicants is \$100.

Tuition – Boarding: The tuition for a boarding student for ERA, Enrichment & Recovery Academy 2010, will be \$3,750. This amount is established by the Board of Trustees and covers the cost of tuition, room and board, daily uniforms, instruction in academic subjects, computer usage fee, sports camp, gym shorts and t-shirts, supervision, textbook rentals, laundry, academic fees, lab fees, routine medical attention and accident insurance.

Tuition – Day: The tuition will be \$2,500. This amount covers the cost of tuition, lunch meal, initial uniform issue, instruction in academic subjects, computer usage fee, supervision, textbook rentals, academic fees, lab fees, routine medical attention and accident insurance.

International/Non-U.S. Citizen Fee: All international applicants who are not citizens of the U.S. will also incur an additional fee of \$400. This administrative fee includes the \$200 SEVIS I-901 fee.

International/U.S. Citizen Fee: All U.S. citizens who reside outside the continental United States will also incur an additional administrative fee of \$200.

Sports Camp – Boarding: Participation is required and the cost is included in the Tuition.

Sports Camp – Day: Participation is optional. The cost of participation is \$500 and includes coaching, supervision and sports uniform package.

Uniforms:

Daily uniform package includes the following:

1 web belt with buckle

4 pr. Khaki shorts

4 MMA polo shirts

* All boarding students will also receive a laundry bag and sock bag

Sports uniform package includes the following:

4 MMA t-shirts

4 pr MMA gym shorts

Items to be Brought from Home:

The following required articles should be brought from home. The Academy will furnish all sheets, pillowcases and towels.

- Each student's personal clothing and uniforms will be marked at MMA with each student's name and property number.
- Students may bring laptops, cell phones, and iPod/MP3 type players. No large stereos, TVs, fans or appliances are permitted.
- Each student should bring equipment for those sports which interest him/her.
- Keepsakes such as rings, watches or other articles of real or sentimental value should not be brought to school. In general, surplus items should be excluded from a student's equipment. Any articles brought from home should be identified with the student's property number and name.

School Supplies

Students should bring from home the necessary supplies such as notebooks, paper, pencils, pens, etc. Supplies can also be purchased or replenished through the Quartermaster Department, or students are welcome to purchase supplemental supplies elsewhere.

Spending Money/Allowance

Parents are responsible to provide any additional spending money to the student. \$15-\$25 per week is recommended.

Property Damage

Property damage by students will be repaired at their expense. Where individual responsibility cannot be definitively determined, cost will be prorated. The school will not be held liable for loss, theft or damage to student's personal items.

Physical and Immunization Requirements

All students must have a camp physical and immunization records on file prior to June 23, 2010. Forms are available on the website.

Absences

In the best interests of all students, it is imperative that absences from Summer School be restricted to those indicated on the Calendar of Events. Special leave will be granted in case of serious illness of the student, serious illness or death in the student's immediate family, or other emergency at home. In cases of all absences caused by sickness or other emergencies, the teacher and student concerned will accept joint responsibility for the completion of the work missed.

Final Grades and Completion

The Summer School session is not complete until the conclusion of Final Assembly on Friday, July 23, 2010. At the discretion of the President, all credits may be withheld in the event a student does not remain through the Final Assembly. Official grades or transcripts will be mailed to families within 5 business days.

It is important that you make flight arrangements as early as possible to be sure you have flights your son or daughter can meet. The dates of the summer session are published well in advance to accommodate the flight schedules. Students are not allowed to **depart campus early or to return late** from the scheduled open weekend.

If your boy/girl might travel via airline at any time during the summer session, please secure government-issued photo identification prior to his/her arrival on campus.
