

# LEADERSHIP CAMP SUPPLEMENT

July 7 – 20, 2012

This is a military leadership camp for boys, ages 13-17. The camp is a rigorous two week program that teaches campers the basics of leadership while exposing them to a wide variety of adventurous and physically challenging activities.

Activities will include daily physical training, paintball, rappelling, rifle marksmanship, canoeing, pugil sticks, swimming, knot tying, leadership reaction course, first aid training with certification and map reading.

## Camp Costs

The cost of the two week Leadership Camp is \$2,000.00. The Application Fee is \$100.00 is non-refundable and will be applied to the Camp fees upon completion of the application process.

The cost of the Leadership Camp includes all instruction and supervision, use of MMA facilities, lodging, meals, uniforms, laundry, sheets, pillow cases, scheduled recreational activities, equipment use, transportation during the camp, camp photo, and a \$25 per week spending allowance. The cost of the camp does not include personal items, souvenirs or snacks beyond what is provided by the camp.

The uniform package will include for following:

2 pair ACU uniform pants	1 ACU uniform blouse (shirt)
1 ACU uniform cap	5 MMA tan t-shirts
1 ACU uniform belt	2 MMA athletic shorts
2 ACU uniform patches	8 pair boot socks
1 laundry bag	

ACU boots will be provided by the U.S. Army JROTC department at Missouri Military Academy. The boots are property of the U.S. Army JROTC and must be returned to the JROTC department at the conclusion of the Leadership Camp. Campers will be charged \$110 for boots that are not returned.

Schedule of Payment:

1. Application Fee of \$100.00 must be paid with the submission of the Application for Admission.
2. Upon acceptance, the remaining balance of \$1,900.00 is due no later than June 15, 2012.
3. Applications received and accepted after June 15, 2012, will require the balance to be paid prior to Registration on Saturday, July 7, 2012.
4. All payments can be made in cash, money order, certified check or credit card. Credit card payments can be made online using MasterCard, Discover, or American Express. A 2.75% convenience fee will be applied to credit card payments.

## Laundry

Camper's laundry will be washed in the Cadet Laundry at the conclusion of the first week, in preparation for the second week of Leadership Camp. There is no additional charge for this service.

## Valuables, Airline Tickets, and Cash

Leadership Camp officials will collect airline tickets, valuables, and large sums of cash for safe keeping upon the camper's arrival. The camper will be able to purchase items at the Canteen. Airline tickets, valuables and remaining cash will be returned to the camper at the conclusion of the camp.

## Transportation, Arrival, and Departure

**Transportation:** If advance arrangements are made the Leadership Camp officials, camp representatives will meet the camper at the St. Louis airport, and return him to the St. Louis airport at the conclusion of camp.

1. If your son will be arriving by airline, please purchase his tickets for arrival Saturday, July 7, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. Please notify Camp officials immediately if flight is delayed.
2. Departures should be scheduled from St. Louis between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Friday, July 20.
3. There will be a charge of \$100 each way for MMA transportation.
4. Please email camp officials a copy of your son's flight itinerary to [info@missourimilitaryacademy.org](mailto:info@missourimilitaryacademy.org).
5. No other transportation will be provided for early or late arrivals or departures.

**Arrival:** Campers are to arrive for Registration on Saturday, July 7, 2012, 12:00 – 3:00 p.m. Please be certain that the camper eats lunch prior to Registration as his first camp meal will be at 6:00 p.m. that evening.

**Departure:** Campers will be dismissed on Friday, July 20, 2012, at 11:30 a.m. Transportation to the St. Louis airport will leave campus at 12:00 p.m. Do NOT schedule a flight before 4:00 p.m.

## Communication

Campers may bring a cell phone from home to communicate with family members. This phone will only be available to campers during free time.

**\*Prescription Medications** (if necessary) will be dispensed by the Camp medical staff and **must be in the original prescription containers.** There is a \$25 fee for dispensing of medications.

## **What to Leave at Home**

Do **not** allow electronic games, computers, televisions, fans, stereos, fireworks, tobacco products, matches, lighters, knives or any form of weapon to be brought from home. The Leadership Camp is not responsible for lost items or theft; therefore items of value, such as jewelry, keepsakes, etc., are not to be brought to camp.

Campers are not allowed to have vehicles. If a camper must drive himself to the Leadership Camp, he **MUST** give the Camp officials his vehicle's keys until excused from the camp.

## **Canteen/Camp Store**

The Canteen has postage stamps, snacks, drinks, personal toiletries, and MMA souvenirs, such as mugs, sweatshirts, shirts, etc. Items are sold as CASH only.

## **Awards Ceremony**

There will be an Awards Ceremony at 11 a.m. for the Leadership Camp on Friday, July 20. Parents are invited. Campers must be picked up no earlier than 11:30 a.m. and no later than 3:30 p.m.

## **Non-discrimination Policy**

Missouri Military Academy Leadership Camp admits campers of any race, color, religion and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to all other campers.

## **Reservation of Rights**

The MMA Leadership Camp reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant, or to require the withdrawal of any camper when such refusal or withdrawal is in the best interest of the Camp.

The MMA Leadership Camp accept campers with the expressed understanding that the camper and parents will comply with the rules and regulations of the Camps listed in this brochure, in the *Statement of Understanding* that is found on the Application for Admission to the Camp and on the Camp Regulations that are given to campers and their parents.

If a camper is dismissed for misconduct, is withdrawn by his parents/guardians, or otherwise leaves the Academy before the end of Camp, then fees paid shall be retained by the Camp as earned or liquidated damages.

## **Responsibility for Injuries, and Loss of Personal Items**

The MMA Leadership Camp will not be responsible for injuries to campers or loss of their personal items at Camp or while en route to or from Camp.

# How to Apply for Camp

1. Return the completed and signed **Application for Admission** with the non-refundable application fee of \$100.00.
2. The following forms must be received and reviewed before the Application for Admission will be approved.
  - a. **Certificate of Health**, which include the **Physical Examination, Immunization Record,** and the **Medical Emergency Treatment Form**. Please schedule the physical exam after April 1, 2012.
  - b. **Certificate of Eligibility**
  - c. Two (2) **General Character References**
  - d. **All forms should be returned**
3. The forms listed above will be emailed to you upon receipt of the Application for Admission. Forms can also be mailed upon request.
