The mission of Stuart Flying is to provide excellence in flight training so that students can become safe and competent pilots.

Minimum Flight Training Costs:

Airplane rental (\$65/hour) 40 hour minimum	\$2,600
Instructor fee (\$40/hour) 20 hour minimum	\$800
Fuel (approximately \$32/hour)	\$1,400
Ground school	\$750
Flight training supplies	\$80

These are minimum FAA flight time requirements; most students require more training than the basic requirements. The additional training will incur charges for the aircraft, fuel and instructional time. The average cost will be approximately \$7,500.

Eligibility requirements:

To be eligible for a private pilot certificate, a person must:

- Be 16 years of age to solo
- Be at least 17 years of age to take the private pilot exam
- Be able to read, speak, write, and understand the English language
- Receive a logbook endorsement from an authorized instructor
- 40 hours of flight time
- 10 hours of solo including 5 hours cross country



The training aircraft is a Piper Warrior. This is a 4 place 160 HP low-wing plane which cruises at 130 MPH.
